2008 Texas SuperCourse™ Racing Series for Watercraft

(12-12-07 / Houston, Texas)

Texas-based watercraft racing promoter, TeamSport Racing Promotions, Inc., as sanctioned by the American Power Boat Association (APBA), releases their schedule for the “2008 Texas SuperCourse™ Racing Series” for Watercraft.

The season schedule will kick off in May, as opposed to April in recent years, and will conclude at the APBA SuperCourse™ Nationals in September. Comprised of five events (including Nationals) on five weekends, the 2008 season will feature all two-day formats, with racing on Saturday and Sunday.

The first three weekend events will host the popular Texas AquaMoto Series. The fourth weekend will feature the Texas Cup Championship, and the final weekend will showcase the SuperCourse™ Nationals.

Each Saturday and Sunday of the first four weekends (non-Nationals) will also be considered as APBA National Highpoints rounds, allowing competitors eight (8) separate rounds to score overall points from, before the National event. SuperCourse™ racers across the nation can score points in designated events, including nationals, in their pursuit of the APBA National Highpoint Championships in different classes.

The 2008 SuperCourse™ Nationals will once again be formatted as a two-day, moto-style event. The championship event will also continue to be scored as an individual APBA Highpoint round worth “double points”.

2008 Texas SuperCourse™ Racing Series for Watercraft

The Texas AquaMoto Series started in 1999 as a point series to determine the best watercraft endurance racers in Texas and surrounding states. When TeamSport Racing created the sport of SuperCourse™ racing, the series became the standard benchmark for the new sport. With the first three weekends of the 2008 season devoted to the point series, racers will have six separate rounds to prove their stature. The series is scored separately, and with a different point system, than the APBA National Highpoint system.

The fourth annual Texas Cup Championship will follow last year's format, and will award individual Texas Cup championships to racers in different classes, as well as the perennial Texas Cup trophy to the best Team. For the first time however, an unlimited number of teams will be allowed to compete for the Texas Cup trophy.

The tentative schedule* for the 2008 Texas SuperCourse™ Series is as follows:

Texas AquaMoto Series

- MAY 3/4.....Somerville Lake, Texas
- JUNE 7/8.....Belton Lake, Texas (BLORA WaterFest)
- JULY 12/13.....Lake Bryan, Texas

Texas Cup Championship

- AUGUST 9/10.....Somerville Lake, Texas

SuperCourse Nationals

- SEPTEMBER (13/14).....Lake Dallas, Texas (Lake Dallas Water Fest)
