APBA National Tour to Return to North Carolina



Eastpointe, MI - The APBA today announces the final tour stop on the 2009 HYDRO-TURF APBA Watercross National Tour. The final Tour stop will be invading Denver, North Carolina (just north of Charlotte) on July 25-26 at a brand new Lincoln County Park on beautiful Lake Norman. Surf and Turf Promotions will be producing the North Carolina event. The Lake Norman National Watercraft Challenge will be rounds 9 and 10 of the HYDRO-TURF APBA Watercross National Tour and also carry points for the 12th Annual Sea Doo Surf and Turf Championships. Denver is located on the west side of Lake Norman and minutes from Mooresville, NC which is known as Race City USA and home to many of the NASCAR teams.



The setting is a large fresh-water lake, which can get rough at times and provide some high-speed racing and awesome racing action. The last National Tour event on Lake Norman there were approximately 10,000 spectators that attended the event, with the large majority of them around the course perimeter, outside of the race course, watching from boats.
