2009 HYDRO-TURF APBA WATERCROSS NATIONAL TOUR HEADS TO LAKE ELSINORE

U.S. National Tour to Visit California After 7 Year Hiatus

There were some great battles at the opening rounds in Parker, Arizona and the battle will continue in Lake Elsinore.

The action both on and off the water is going to be intense with all riders vying for victory and their share of prize money. In addition to event prize money, Supporting sponsor Sea-Doo has posted an impressive contingency program for the racers. The Lake Elsinore event is great opportunity for the fans to get up close and personal with all the racers.
