## **Canadian Runabout Racers to Earn IJSBA National Numbers in Belle River**

The APBA is excited to announce that the IJSBA has made an announcement related to the Belle River event and the Canadian racers. Since the Naut Wukin Racing Eastern Canadian Nationals will be the only event for 2010 in Canada that will include Runabout racing, the IJSBA has awarded the Belle River event the right to count as the national points event for Canadian RUNABOUT racers to earn national numbers for Canada.

Points will be accumulated from the two days of racing in each class based on the IJSBA 60 point system. The racers will earn the right to run that number at the 2010 IJSBA World Finals and for the 2011 race season. Canadian racers are required to run a "C" after their earned number. Canadian racers that have been running the APBA National Tour and earn a number from the APBA also have the option of running their APBA earned number. Canadian Racers will earn the number based on where they finished in the class entered.

While there will be both US and Canadian racers in the different classes only the Canadian racers will compete against each other for the earned Canadian numbers. You must live in Canada to earn a Canadian number.

Also, Pro Am Runabout and Pro Am Ski class winners will receive a \$25.00 credit towards a Pro Am entry at the 2010 IJSBA World Finals (credits cannot be combined or transferred).

This is great news and an exciting addition to what should be one of the best races of the summer!
